Do you feel happy coming to school?

The three children who said no were all boys, from year 4, year 2 and year 1. The year 4 boy has ASC and has struggled with the transition to year 4-strategies are in place and hopefully this answer will change when the next questionnaire goes out. The boy from year 2 is persistently absent, when asked why he's not happy he said he forgets to bring his glasses to school. SENCo has spoken to mum about this. The boy from year 1 said he is unhappy because he wants to play with his friend, who is in reception.

Is there something that you used to find really hard but now find much easier?

The four children who answered no were all from year 2. When asked, they said they have always found everything easy. The three children who couldn't answer were from year 1-couldn't access the question.
