#### Composing for protest

Create fragments of songs that can develop into fully fledged songs.

Play drum patterns, basslines, and riffs on a variety of instruments as part of a group.

#### **Twinkle Variations**

Use *Twinkle, twinkle little star* as a composing tool, theme and variations form, passacaglia, improvisation.

#### Race

create music to accompany a short film about a race, composing an extended melody and accompaniment. Motif, ostinato, beat.
