


Reading Plus Guide for Northcote Parents:



1) Search 'Reading Plus student login' on Google






3) Enter the site code (rpnorth48) - no capital letters and click next

4) Type in user name: first name in full and first letter of surname. For example Bob Jacobs would be 'bobj'

5) Type in password (qwerty). This is the same for all users, so that access is easy. PLEASE DO NOT LOGIN AS SOMEBODY ELSE!

6) If you are a new user: Watch the videos to tell you what to do next. Click 'go on' at the bottom right.

TOP TIPS:

- *'Irate' is how many words you have read independently
- *'Grate' is how many words have read in your guided window (the box that moves along)
- *You can click on the stories that are on your level when you press 'start lessons'
- *Choose a category that you like for your text
- *Remember to try and read other categories too
- *Your 'rainbow circle'/pie chart (bottom left of your dashboard) shows you which stories you have read. Next to this is boxes with stories you have read. Drag them across to keep a count of how many stories you have read.
