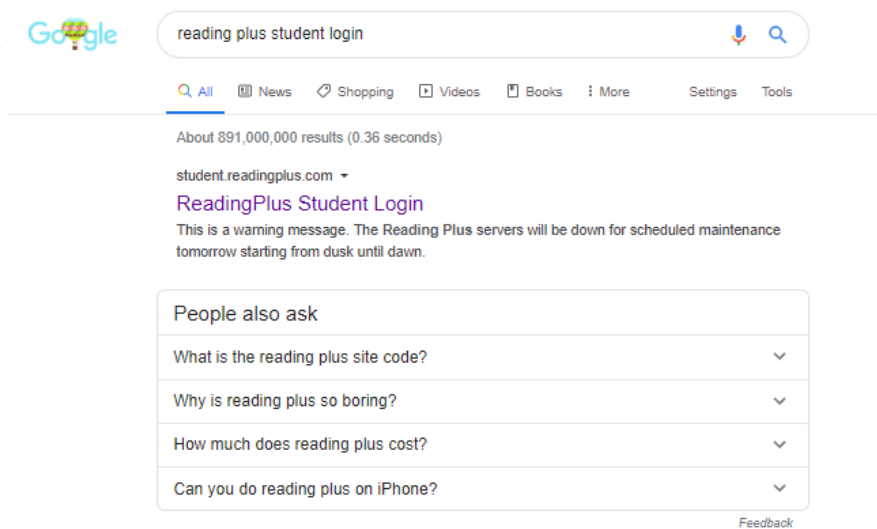


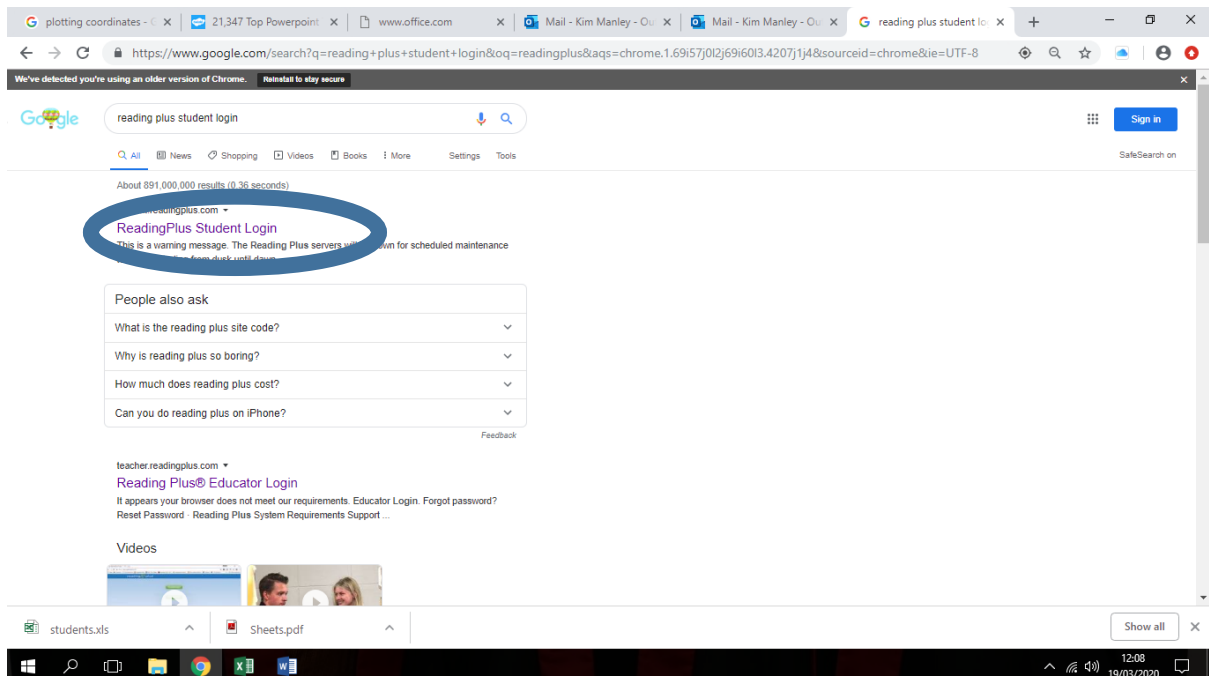
## Reading Plus Guide for Northcote Parents:

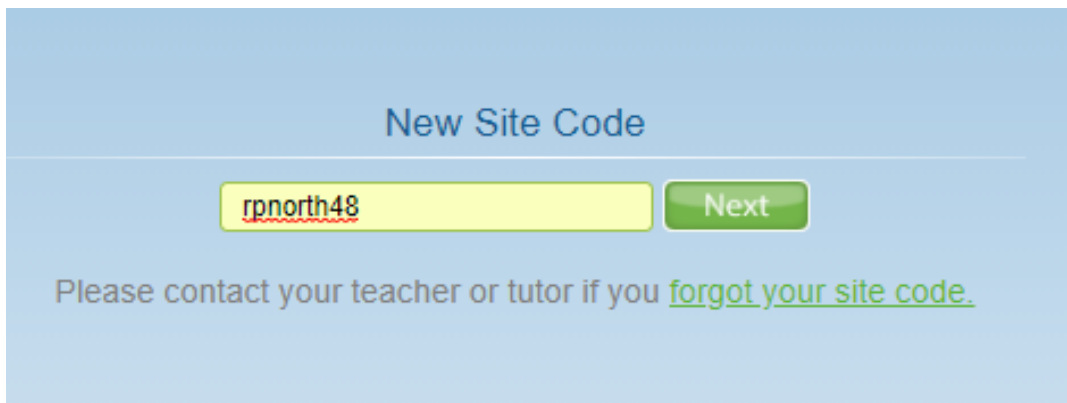
1) Search 'Reading Plus student login' on Google



2) Click on the first link

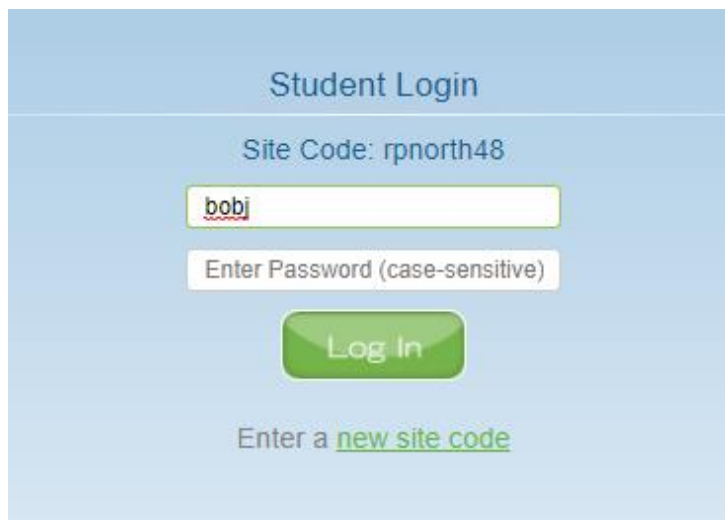


- 3) Enter the side code (rpnorth48) - no capital letters and click next

- 4) Type in user name: first name in full and first letter of surname. For example Bob Jacobs would be 'bobj'

- 5) Type in password (qwerty). This is the same for all users, so that access is easy. PLEASE DO NOT LOGIN AS SOMEBODY ELSE!
- 6) If you are a new user: Watch the videos to tell you what to do next. Click 'go on' at the bottom right.

## TOP TIPS:

- \*'Irate' is how many words you have read independently
- \*'Grate' is how many words have read in your guided window (the box that moves along)
- \*You can click on the stories that are on your level when you press 'start lessons'
- \*Choose a category that you like for your text
- \*Remember to try and read other categories too
- \*Your 'rainbow circle'/pie chart (bottom left of your dashboard) shows you which stories you have read. Next to this is boxes with stories you have read. Drag them across to keep a count of how many stories you have read.
