If you can, try to keep to our school routine! Follow these tasks and see below for extra information about them.

TASK ONE - Get your brain going with 5-a-day.

TASK TWO - Reading. Spend 30 minutes on Reading Plus or reading on Bug Club.

TASK THREE - Maths. Today we will be multiplying numbers. Make sure you set it out correctly - I have put examples and your task below!

TASK FOUR - English. Today, we are focusing on expanded noun phrases. Go through the slides below, there are some mini tasks and a main activity.

TASK FIVE - Spellings - find this week's spelling task below. When we come back to school on Friday, we will have a spelling test of this week's and last week's spellings.

TASK SIX - Earth and Space. This week in school, we would have been focusing on Earth and Space as we missed it during Year 5 due to the school closures. Today, we will be looking at the planets in our solar system. See below for you task.

Adjectives

A timid cat



Possessive nouns

The neighbour's cat
