



BREAKFAST CLUB POLICY

‘Caring, Learning, Growing’

Time 8.00 – 8.45 am

At Breakfast Club we are committed to providing families of Northcote Primary School with an extended school facility, offering breakfast in a safe and secure environment at the beginning of each school day. Children are admitted after a completed registration form is received.

There is a requirement to book in advance, via the school office or with Mrs Hill, Mrs Munn or our Deputy Head Teacher Miss Graham.

Breakfast Club begins at 8.00am, when children are received and registered by Mrs Hill, Mrs. Munn, Mrs Bell. At the end of breakfast club, they are then delivered to their individual classes at 8:45am. Both Mrs Hill and Mrs Munn are First Aid trained.

The aims of the club are as follows:

- To give parents the opportunity to work outside school hours by offering low cost childcare.
- To prepare children for their day by providing a healthy, nutritious breakfast, including a choice of cereals and bagels (provided by Magic Breakfast).
- To promote health and personal hygiene by ensuring children wash their hands before eating.
- To provide a home-from-home atmosphere where children feel nurtured.
- To help children develop friendly, positive relationships.

The current prices are (with effect from September 2020):

From 8.00am until 8.45am, including breakfast £1.50 per session (or £6 for a full week)

You must ensure that you sign your child in on the register each day.

Main gate will be closed at 8:20am and staff will not be able to accept your child after this time.

Our prices are kept as low as possible, to cover costs only, and prices will only be increased if necessary to avoid running at a loss.
