EYFS	Throughout Nursery and Reception, our children's ideas and imagination are nurtured allowing them to express themselves creatively through well-resourced provision and carefully planned learning opportunities. In Nursery our children have a wide range of opportunities to explore making marks use a range of media and develop their drawing skills by creating shapes with continuous lines. They explore pattern, colour, 3D forms through exciting thematic units. In Reception, children are encouraged to be more purposeful with their artwork, producing pieces which replicate things in real life for example pictures and paintings of animals. They explore 3D form through making collages and weaving different materials together and develop their understanding of colour by exploring tints and shades.
