Dear Parent/Carer

This letter is to inform you of some changes to home time and the release of children at the end of the school day.

Over the summer, we have installed a fence from the entrance gate to the main office. There is a gate within this fence for access to the Early Years and for children to enter/exit from that will be open in the mornings and at home time. This is referenced as the 'walkway gate'.

Please see the information below for where to collect your child from and what time they will be released:

Reception and Nursery- Children released at 3.20pm

Collect children from their classroom doors. Enter the Early Years outdoor area through the walkway gate and then through the EYFS Gate.

Year 1- Children released at 3.20pm

Collect children directly from classroom doors.

Year 2- Children released at 3.20pm

Collect children from the Performing Arts Room Doors.

Year 3- Children released at 3.30pm

Collect children from the Performing Arts Room Doors.

Year 4- Children released at 3.30pm

Collect children from Breakfast club door.

Year 5- Children released at 3.30pm

Children will line up along the walkway path and exit through the walkway gate.

Year 6- Children released at 3.30pm

Children who have permission to walk home will be dismissed first. Those who are to be collected will line up alongside school building by the admin offices.
