There are several events being happening in school next week.

## Monday 11th November-Remembrance.

Children will learn about what remembrance is and the whole school will observe a minute silence at 11 o' clock. Children are welcome to wear a poppy to school on that day if they wish to.

#### Tuesday 12th November- Odd Socks Day

As part of Anti-bullying Week, we are inviting children to wear odd socks to school on Tuesday. The aim of this is to promote the acceptance of others who may be different to ourselves. This is optional and children do not have to participate if they don't want to.

Throughout the week, the children will also receive age-appropriate sessions focusing on what bullying is and what positive actions we can all take to prevent bullying from happening.

## Thursday 14th November-Reception Open Evening
