Year 6 children should come to school at 8:30 am on these days for free breakfast club and to get settled before the tests start.

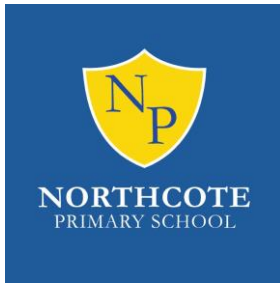
Walk to School Week- Monday 19th May- Friday 23rd May
